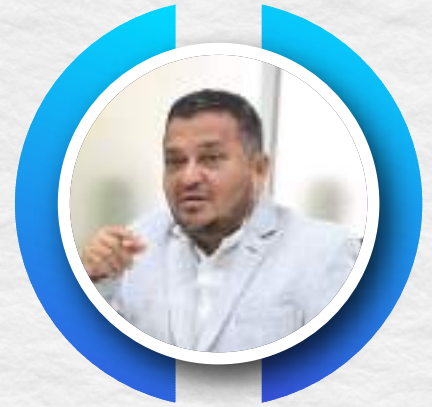

PSYCHOLOGICAL ASSESSMENT : (cognitive insights)

At Mamta Rehabilitation Centre, we provide comprehensive psychological assessments tailored to the unique needs of each individual. Our assessments are conducted by qualified professionals to evaluate cognitive, emotional, and behavioural aspects, aiding in the diagnosis and development of personalised intervention plans. These evaluations are designed to support children and individuals with special needs, ensuring they receive the most appropriate care and guidance to enhance their overall well-being and development.



PARENT COUNSELLING : STRENGTHENING THE FOUNDATION

We provide emotional support and practical guidance to parents, empowering them to nurture their child's development with confidence.

Our therapists use tailored strategies to address challenging behaviours and foster lasting positive change.



SENSORY THERAPY : ENHANCING DEVELOPMENT THROUGH SENSORY STIMULATION

At our center, we offer comprehensive sensory therapy, incorporating various techniques such as sensory integration activities and dark therapy. Sensory therapy helps children process and respond to sensory inputs more effectively, addressing challenges like sensory overload and sensory processing difficulties. Dark therapy, as part of our approach, provides a controlled environment that allows children to relax and recalibrate by reducing overwhelming stimuli, fostering emotional regulation, and promoting focus. Through tailored sensory experiences, we aim to enhance each child's development and well-being.



REMEDIAL THERAPY : TARGETED SUPPORT FOR DEVELOPMENTAL PROGRESS

Remedial therapy is a specialised form of intervention designed to address and correct specific learning, behavioural, or developmental challenges in children. At our center, we provide personalised remedial therapy to help children improve foundational skills such as reading, writing, and cognitive processing. Each session is tailored to the child's unique needs, ensuring targeted support to enhance their academic abilities and overall development.



GROUP THERAPY : THERAPLAY SATURDAYS

At our center, we offer dynamic group therapy sessions every Saturday, designed to foster social, emotional, and cognitive development. The children are divided into three groups—A, B, and C—to ensure personalised attention and appropriate activity levels. Each session includes a variety of engaging activities that are rotated regularly, allowing for a diverse and stimulating experience. Our goal is to create a supportive environment where each child can thrive through collaborative learning, skill-building, and peer interaction, all while focusing on their unique developmental needs.



PRE-PRIMARY CLASS : FOUNDATIONS OF FUTURE SUCCESS

Our pre-primary class bridges therapy and formal education, offering a nurturing and stimulating environment to prepare children for lifelong academic and personal success. We provide a holistic approach that includes Islamic education, fostering a deep understanding of values and cultural heritage from an early age. Recognising that each child has unique abilities, we tailor our approach to meet their individual needs. Our dedicated team works closely with every child, ensuring that their educational and developmental journey is personalised, supportive, and aligned with their specific strengths and challenges.



HOMEOPATHY (VITAL ESSENCE)

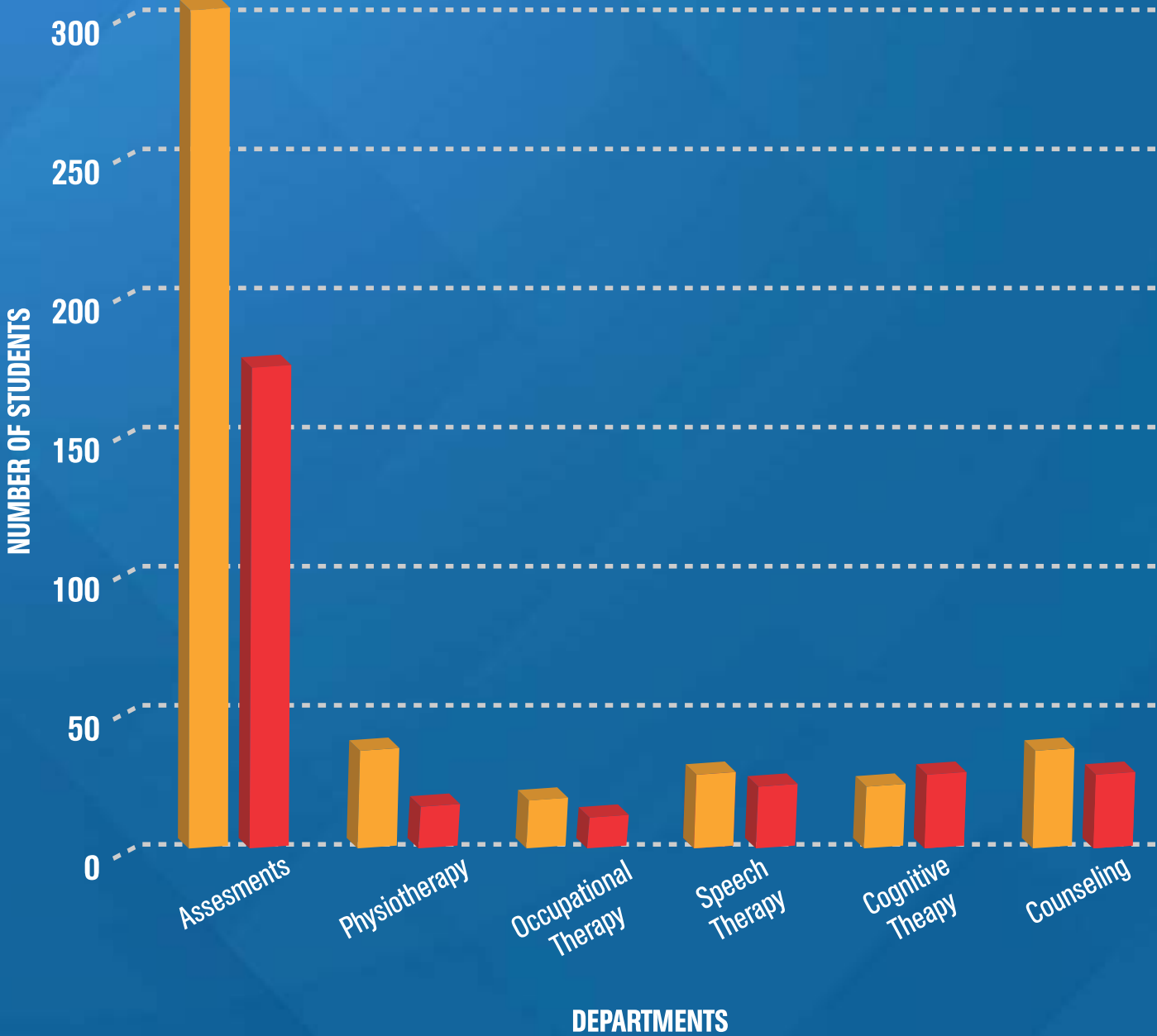

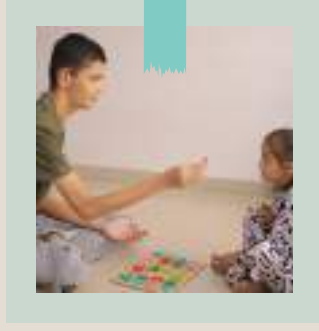
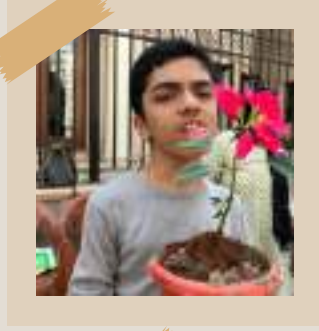
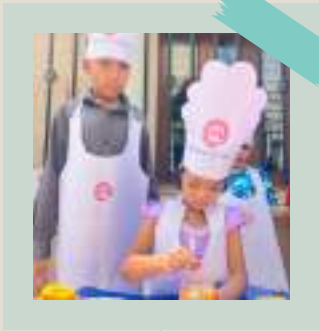


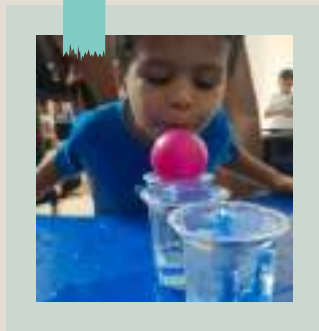
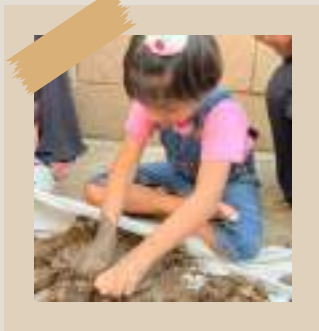
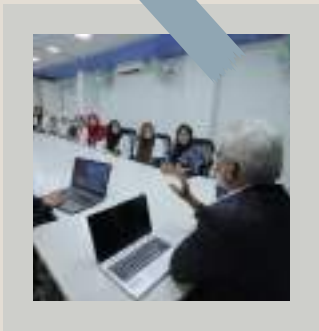
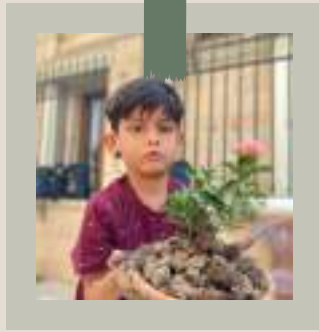
Physiotherapy Day

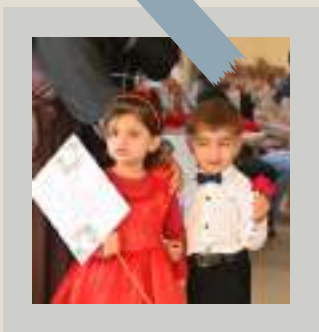
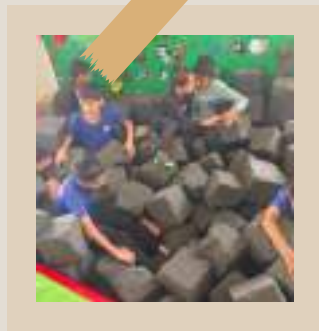
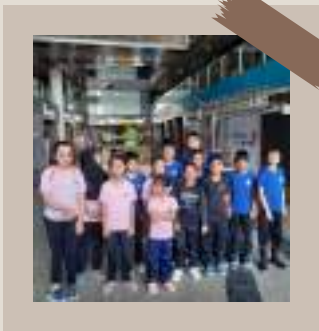

લોકો સ્પેશિયલ બાળકો, દિવ્યાંગ બાળકો, દેવદૂતના બાળકો એવા કેટકેટલાય ઉપનામો આપી બાળકોના એક વર્ગને હંમેશા સમાજથી દૂર રાખે છે. એક ખૂણો આપે છે.

મિત્રો, ભરૂચમાં એક અદ્ભુત સેન્ટર છે, “મમતા રિહેબ સેન્ટર”, કે જે આવા બાળકો માટે, આવા બાળકોના વાલીઓ માટે એક વિસામો બનીને ઊભું રહ્યું છે. ૧૫૦ થી વધુ દિકરા દિકરીઓ છે કે જેને દ્વિતિયોથેરાપી થી લઈ ઓક્યુપેશનલ થેરાપી, સ્પીચ થેરાપી જેવી, જે એક થેરાપીના પ્રત્યેક સેશનની ફી રૂપિયા ૫૦૦-૭૦૦ કે ૧૦૦૦ પ્રતિ કલાકની હોય છે એ તમામે તમામ નિ:શુલ્ક આપવામાં આવે છે.

એમ તો કેટલી બધી વાતો છે જે મેં મારી સગી આંખે જોઈ, અનેક મહાનગરોમાં પણ જોવા ન મળે એવી થેરાપી મમતા રિહેબ સેન્ટરમાં આપવામાં આવે છે.

મિત્રો, સમાજને ખુબ નમ્ર અપીલ છે કે, આપણે અનેક જગ્યા એ દાન આપતા હોય છે, અનેક જગ્યાએ કામ કરતા હોય છે. થોડુંક કામ આ બાળકો માટે કરીએ, થોડુંક ધ્યાન આ બાળકો માટે પણ આપીએ.

કારણ કે ઈશ્વરે જો સમાજમાં આ બાળકોને મોકલ્યાં છે તો એવી શ્રદ્ધા સાથે કે ૮ અજબની વસ્તીમાં ૧૫૦ બાળકો તો સચવાય જ જાયને! એટલી કરૂણા આ ભરૂચ જિલ્લામાં ના નીકળે?

આપ સૌને નમ્ર વિનંતી છે કે આવો સાથે મળીને આ બાળકોને સમજાવે, એના માં-બાપની કરોડરજજુ-પીઠને સીધી કરીએ.

People often call children with special needs by various names—special children, differently-abled, or even angels. Yet, society tends to isolate them and push them to a corner.

Friends, there is an incredible center in Bharuch called “Mamta Rehab Center”, which has become a haven for such children and their parents. Over 150 boys and girls are receiving support here. Therapies such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy—each of which can cost anywhere between ₹500 to ₹1,000 per session—are provided completely free of charge.

I have personally witnessed the remarkable services this center offers, which are rare to find even in major cities.

Friends, I humbly request you all to take a moment to think about these children. We donate and help in many areas; why not extend some of that support to these children as well?

If God has sent these children into this world, it is with the belief that in a population of 8 billion, at least 150 such children can be cared for! Doesn't Bharuch have enough compassion to provide for them?

My heartfelt plea is that we come together to understand these children, stand by their parents, and help ease their burdens.

Let us support initiatives like Mamta Rehab Center in every possible way. Such centers should never struggle due to a lack of funds. With proper training and education, these children can live normal lives like you and me. They have the potential and the wings; society just needs to provide them the sky to fly.

Families like these often face distress because society questions them: “What grade is your child in?” “What does your child do?” “Why hasn't your child started speaking yet?” Instead of asking such questions, let us simply say, “We are with you.”

Mamta Rehab Center does just that—it reaches out to every corner, reassuring families, “You are not alone; we are here for you.” It is often loneliness that amplifies pain. But when these children and their families realize that someone is there to wipe their tears, to stand by them, to comfort them, no despair can overpower them.

Mamta Rehab Center is doing the noble work of wiping tears, providing answers, offering comfort, and standing by these families with love and care.

FATIMA'S JOURNEY OF HOPE

When my daughter Fatima was born, she was so tiny, fragile, and light as a feather. From the moment I held her, I knew she was my miracle, my fighter.

But life threw a challenge our way. Due to her low birth weight, she developed a severe infection. I watched helplessly as her condition worsened, and soon we had no choice but to admit her to the ICU. Those days in the ICU were the darkest days of my life. Seeing my little girl connected to machines, fighting for her life, broke me in ways I cannot put into words. As a mother, all I wanted was to take away her pain and give her strength, but all I could do was pray and trust the doctors and nurses who worked tirelessly to save her.

When she finally stabilised, we thought the worst was over. But then came another devastating blow—paralysis on the left side of her body. She couldn't move her hand or leg, and her tiny body seemed trapped. I was terrified. What kind of life would she have? Could she ever play, laugh, or even walk again?

That's when the doctors referred us to physiotherapy. At first, I was skeptical.

Could therapy really make a difference?

I had so many doubts. But we started the sessions, and slowly, I began to see hope where there was once despair.

The therapists worked with Fatima so patiently, encouraging her every step of the way. They didn't just treat her; they believed in her. At first, she managed to sit up on her own, something that felt like a small miracle. Then, after months of therapy, she began to take her first steps. I remember the day she stood up and walked a few steps barefoot—it felt like the happiest moment of my life.

There were setbacks, of course. She still stumbles sometimes, and her left hand hasn't regained its strength or grip yet.

But when I see her determination, her will to try again after every fall, I know she is a warrior.

As a mother, my heart aches for her struggles, but it also overflows with pride for her courage and gratitude for the people who made this possible. The physiotherapists didn't just help my daughter—they gave her a chance to live a life where she can dream, laugh, and move forward.

Fatima has taught me the true meaning of resilience. She may have fallen, but she rises every time, stronger than before. And to the therapists and everyone who has supported us, thank you for believing in her when it was hard to believe in anything at all. You have given her, and me, a new hope for the future.

This journey isn't over yet, but together, we'll keep moving forward. And I know, one day, Fatima will conquer everything that stands in her way.

Challenges observed in the child during admission:

Absence of speech, Poor Understanding, limited concentration, lack of eye contact, Minimal Socialization, No self-awareness, Difficulty expressing himself, signs of laziness.

Improvement Overview : Umar has shown significant progress, with enhanced understanding, consistent eye contact, improved concentration, and stronger social skills for effective interaction.

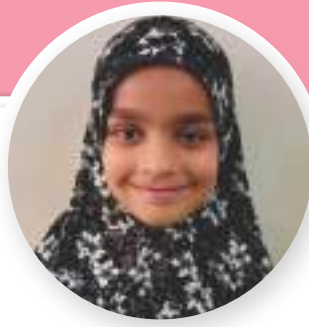


AFFAN WASIM PATEL [Cerebral Palsy]

Challenges observed in the child during admission:

Diagnosed with spastic cerebral palsy, Unable to stand and walk without support, Experienced difficulty with hand coordination and functionality, Faced significant physical challenges affecting mobility and independence.

Improvement Overview : Affan can stand and walk independently, Significant improvement in hand movements.



AJMINA KHANWALA [Hearing Impairment]

Challenges observed in the child during admission:

Absence of speech, limited comprehension of spoken language and instruction.

Improvement Overview : Development of speech skills, progressing from letter recognition to word formation and sentence construction. Significant improvement in understanding and following instruction.



HAMZA MANSURI

Challenges observed in the child during admission:

Issue at the time of admission, Exhibited frequent shouting and low tolerance for seated activities. Struggled with social interaction and engaging in cooperative behavior. Difficulty with handholding and physical contact.

Improvement Overview : Resolved unnecessary shouting. Significant improvement in social interaction skills. Increased tolerance for seated activities. Enhanced ability to follow commands.



DEVANSH SOLANKI [cerebral Palsy]

Challenges observed in the child during admission:

Limited Mobility, Anxiety during Transitions, Social withdrawal, Minimal speech, Avoidance of hand use.

Improvement Overview : Rolls, sits, and stans with improved support. Walks 15+ minutes with improved gait, uses both hands for activities, engages socially, GNFM(GROSS MOTOR FUNCTION MEASURE) : 63%.

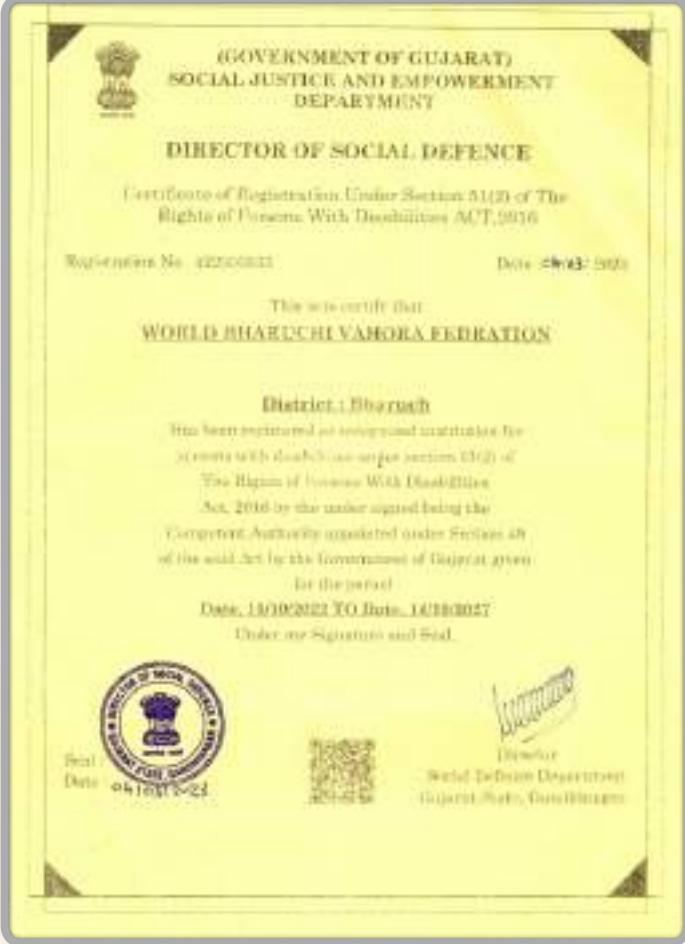
