The projects launched under our key missions have brought changes and inspired hope across all generations of our community.



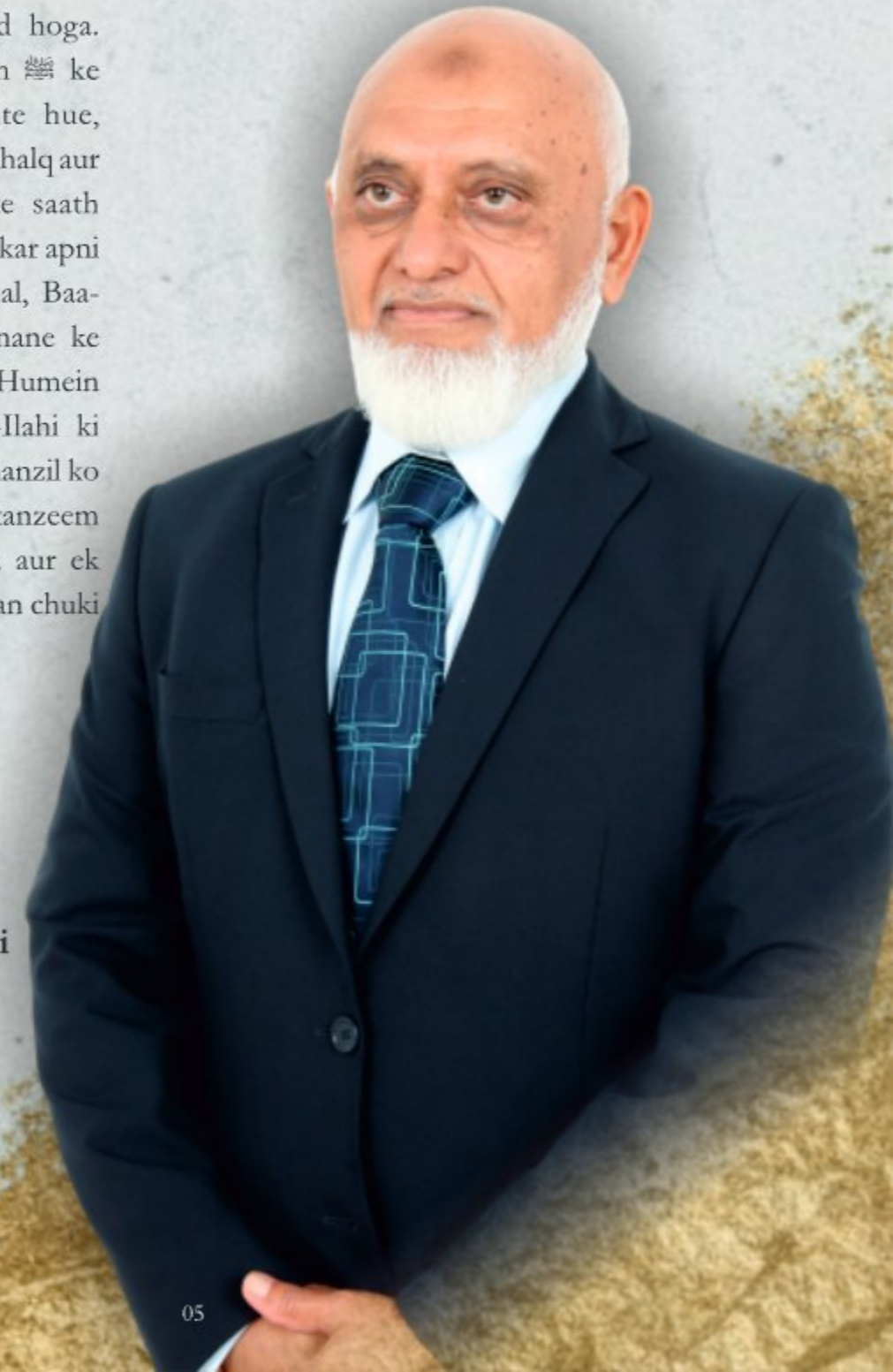
In sha Allah, This upcoming landmark will serve as a dynamic center for learning, collaboration & community service, ensuring continued growth and unity for generations ahead.

Yet our people longed for something deeper a platform that could

connect every soul under one umbrella. And thus, WBVF became that roof, that bridge, and that home the symbol of unity our community had awaited for generations.

Those days of sacrifice were the first chapters of our sincerity, written with tears, prayers, and unforgettable moments of courage.



As the world healed, WBVF began building a strong organisational structure from villages to blocks, from zones to national chapters until every corner of our community had a representative who carried the amanat with humility and responsibility. Today, with Allah's help, our network breathes across India and beyond, led by people who work quietly without seeking recognition, rewards, or applause.

Our journey expanded into education the light that breaks every darkness. WBVF believes that if you educate one child, you uplift entire generations. Through scholarships, mentorship, career guidance, Mission Buniyad, Secondary & Higher secondary Education, Commerce Championship, and support from primary school to higher studies, WBVF strives for one dream: every child in our community must stand educated and dignified.

Our Mission Kafalat grew from the Hadith of the Prophet Hazarat Muhammad ﷺ "I and the one who cares for an orphan will be together in Jannah."

With this Hadith as our compass, WBVF supports orphans, widows, and destitute sisters not merely with financial aid, but with emotional, social, and spiritual support. Our goal is not to make them dependent; our goal is to make them independent. We are committed to giving them opportunities for employment and dignity, InshaAllah.

To free our families from the prison of interest (riba), WBVF established an interest-free microfinance system under the Co-operative Society. We do not believe in charity that creates dependency; we believe in empowerment that creates honour. Because charity feeds a moment but empowerment feeds a lifetime.

Our Mamta Rehab Centre is a home of

compassion for special children who are not a burden but an Amanat from Allah. With therapy, care, love, and acceptance, WBVF strives to give these children dignity, hope, and a full life. And our matrimonial service ensures that the youth of our community find pure, Islamic, and suitable life partners with guidance and modesty.

Behind every achievement of WBVF every project, every smile, every transformation stand the hearts and hands of our 13 BODs, our hardworking team, our volunteers, coordinators, and the countless silent heroes who work day and night for the community. They expect nothing in return except the pleasure of Allah.

If today the community stands stronger, it is because our team stood firmer.

progress of our community. Our struggle is not for name, fame, or position. It is for the upliftment of the Ummah the progress of the Millat and the pleasure of Allah.



- 112 students from the PMET CA Adoption Scheme at the Bharuch Center prepared intensively for the PMET 2025–26 exams. To enhance their interview readiness, a mock interview session was hosted on 10th April 2025 at Husheniya Vidya Bhavan.

Each program conducted throughout the year plays a crucial role in strengthening students' foundational knowledge, enhancing their exam preparedness, and building a mindset towards their success.



- An Orientation Program for the CA Foundation Batch 2025 was conducted on 26th May 2025 at the MMMCT Campus, Bharuch, helping students understand the course structure, expectations, and study strategies.
- A result review meeting was held to analyze performance outcomes and identify areas of improvement. During this session, the team also facilitated students who cleared the exam, acknowledging their hard work.



- The team honored an inspiring visit of WBVF World President, Hon. Haji Ayoob Sir, whose presence encouraged students to aim higher in their academic journey.

- On 14th August 2025, a Motivational & Islamic Lecture was organized, providing students with spiritual upliftment, moral guidance, and renewed motivation to pursue excellence.

CET provides a strong foundation by assessing students' knowledge and skills, and its impact is evident through **improved academic performance, higher confidence levels, and increased access to government scholarships.**

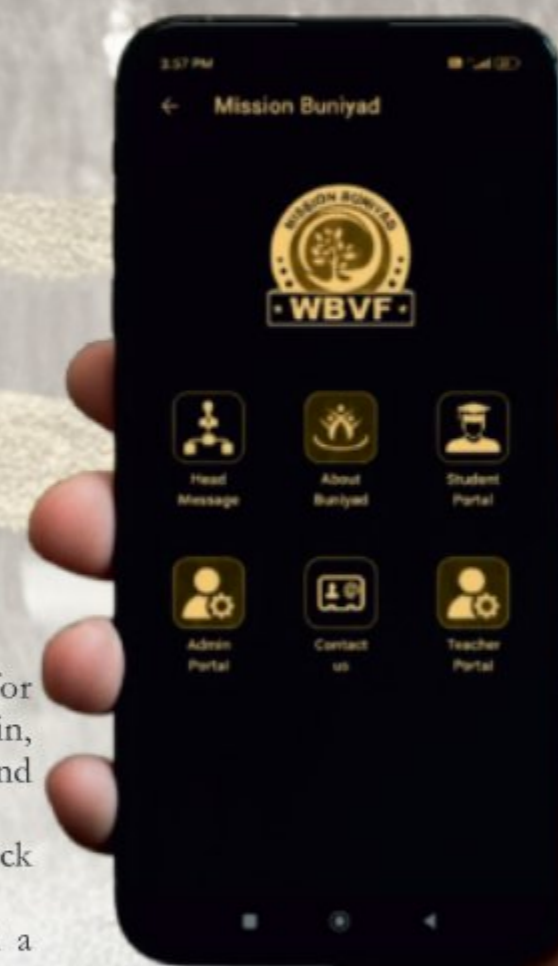

## WBVF Mobile Application

**New Update** To make learning easier and more accessible for every student, Mission Buniyad has taken another big step forward!

On 1st October 2025, online registration officially began on the WBVF App under the Mission Buniyad Project for students preparing for CET and PSE exams.

This new update has been specially designed to help students prepare more efficiently, stay consistent with their studies, and track their progress, all in one place.



### Student Portal

This section is created especially for students. After registration and login, students can easily fill in their personal and educational details.

- They can take daily practice tests and instantly check their results.
- Answer keys are provided after every test and a topper list is displayed to motivate students and encourage healthy competition.



### Admin Portal

The admin section helps teachers and coordinators manage all learning activities smoothly.

- They can create daily quizzes and weekend tests for students.
- They can also review test performances, arrange retests, and maintain a question bank for future exams. Additionally, the portal allows easy management of schools and admins.

Under Mission Buniyad, several key programs were conducted across all 6 blocks. These included regular parents' meetings, academic workshops, and structured tests to track students' progress. These activities ensured consistent monitoring, stronger parent-school coordination, and better academic preparedness among students.



- On July 27, 2025 Parenting Seminar was Organized at Rangoon Hall, Bharuch, bringing together over 400 students and parents from 170+ schools under the banner of Mission Buniyad.
- On August 6, 2025 CET Orientation was Conducted at WBVF Office for CET-2025 aspirants to provide exam guidance and motivation.
- Village-level Parents Meetings Held across Jambusar, Amod, Vagra, Bharuch Rural-1, Rural-2, and Bharuch City to guide students featured in the CET-2025 merit list.
- These initiatives resulted in improved student performance, higher participation, stronger foundational learning.

**Key Highlights:**

- CET Tests: Over 60 online and two offline tests conducted, followed by a 3rd Offline Test & Parenting Seminar at Amod on March 16, 2025, included a CET Mock Test and Child-Friendly Parenting Seminar by Dr. Meghnaben Joshi.
- Prize Distribution Programs held in Jambusar and Vagra honored students excelling in Gyan Sadhna, NMMS, CET, and PSE, with 201 students and 52 teachers recognized.
- On June 2025 Pravesh Utsav was organised for total of 654 certificates for NMMS, CET, and CGMS achievers.



# Secondary, Higher Secondary Education

For years, WBVF has worked at the grassroots, nurturing the dreams of students up to the 8th grade. But a critical question kept surfacing: What happens after primary education? Where do these young minds go next? And more importantly, how do they find the path that aligns with who they truly are? This reflection sparked a powerful shift. In July 2025, WBVF made a pivotal decision: Our responsibility doesn't end at the primary level, it begins there. To bridge the gap between schooling and real-world aspirations, WBVF expanded its educational mission to include Secondary

and Higher Secondary levels (Std. 9 to 12). As part of this initiative, a total of 152 schools are currently connected to the project

#### Key Highlights:

Professional psychologist introduced the RIASEC Aptitude Test, piloted in 12 selected schools. After that, They explained the test's purpose, operation, scoring, and result interpretation. Teachers in 12 schools were trained to administer it effectively.

#### Current Status:

The Aptitude Test was conducted on 28th June 2025 in the 12 pilot schools.

# Competitive Exams

The WBVF Competitive Exams initiative was launched with a clear vision: to open the doors of opportunity for our community's youth and guide them towards prestigious government careers.

Recognizing the growing demand for skilled teachers, WBVF began offering dedicated coaching for TET (Teacher Eligibility Test) and TAT (Teacher Aptitude Test) the two essential examinations required for teaching positions.

Through this initiative, WBVF aims to empower youths with confidence and knowledge required to compete at higher levels. Ultimately, the goal is to prepare well-qualified educators who can contribute to uplifting the academic standard of schools and inspire the next generation of learners.

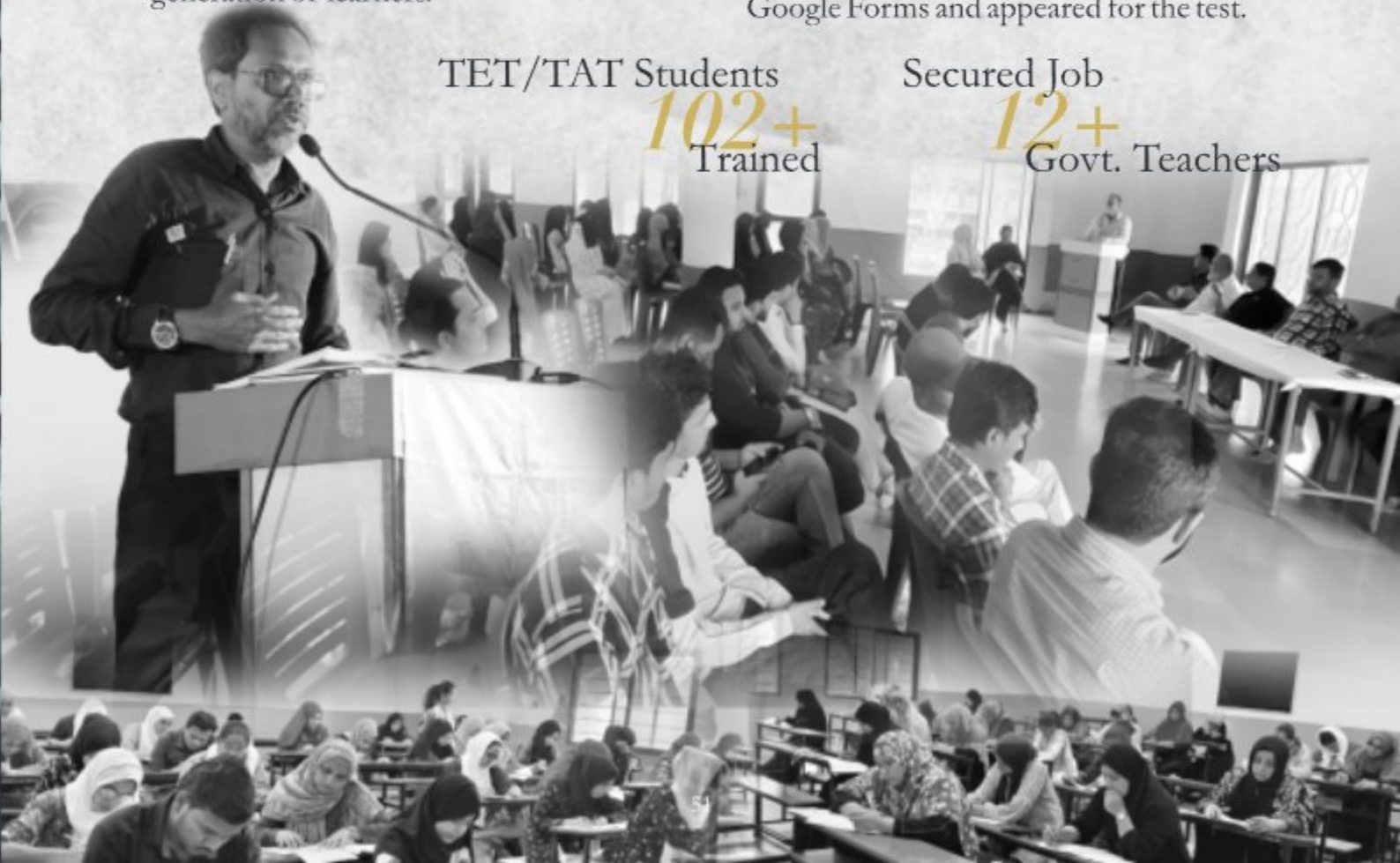
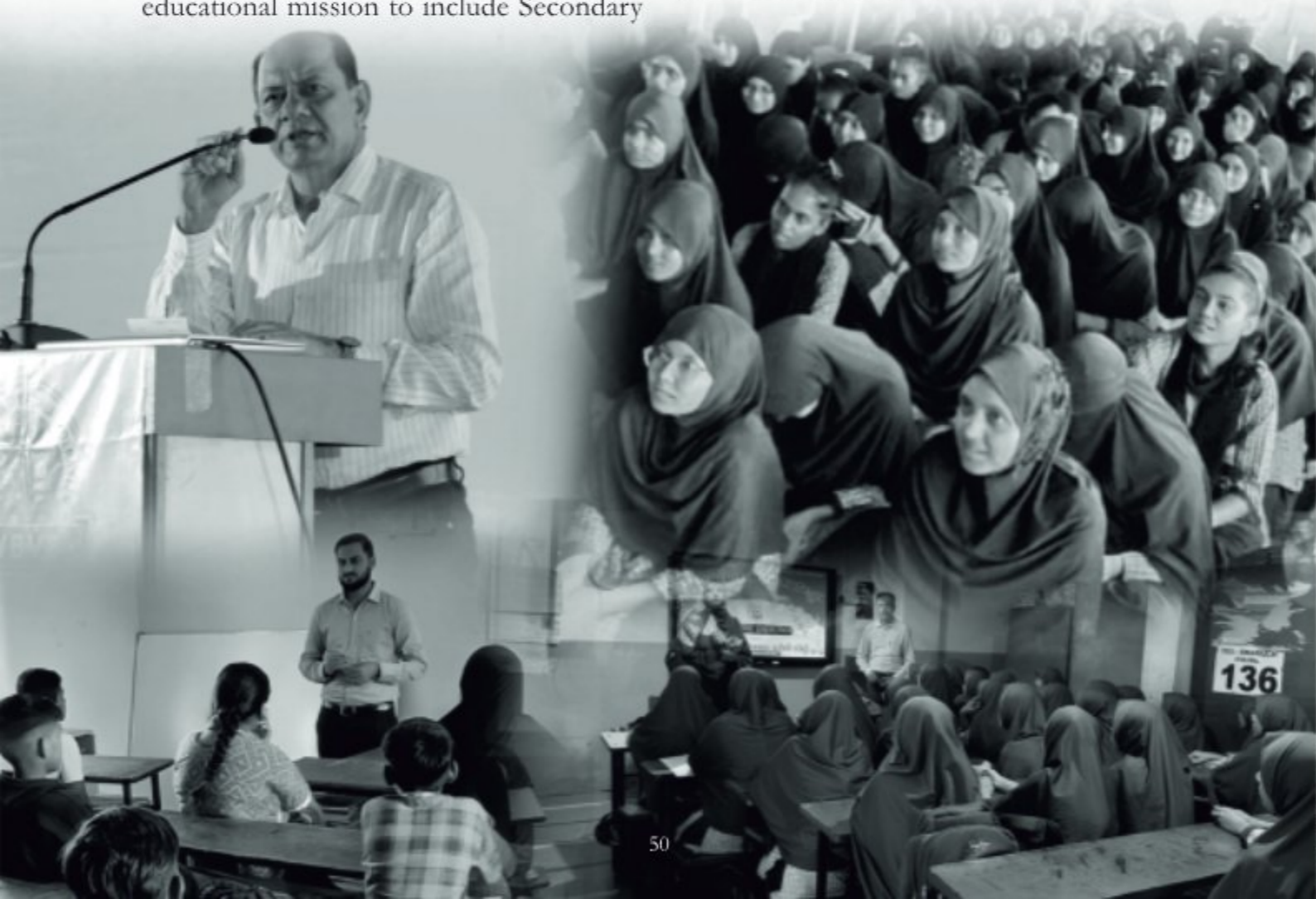

#### Commencement of TET-TAT 2025 Classes

The TET-TAT Classes 2025 officially began on Saturday, 13th September 2025, jointly organized by WBVF and MMMCT to guide aspirants towards excellence. Currently, 44 students are enrolled in the offline batches.

#### OMR-Based Mock Test

On 25th October, 2025, an offline OMR based mock test was organized for TET 1 & 2 and TAT students at MMMCT. The test included participants from both offline classroom training and online learning modules, following the syllabus and structure prescribed by the State Examination Board for TET 1 & TET 2. A total of 76 students registered through Google Forms and appeared for the test.

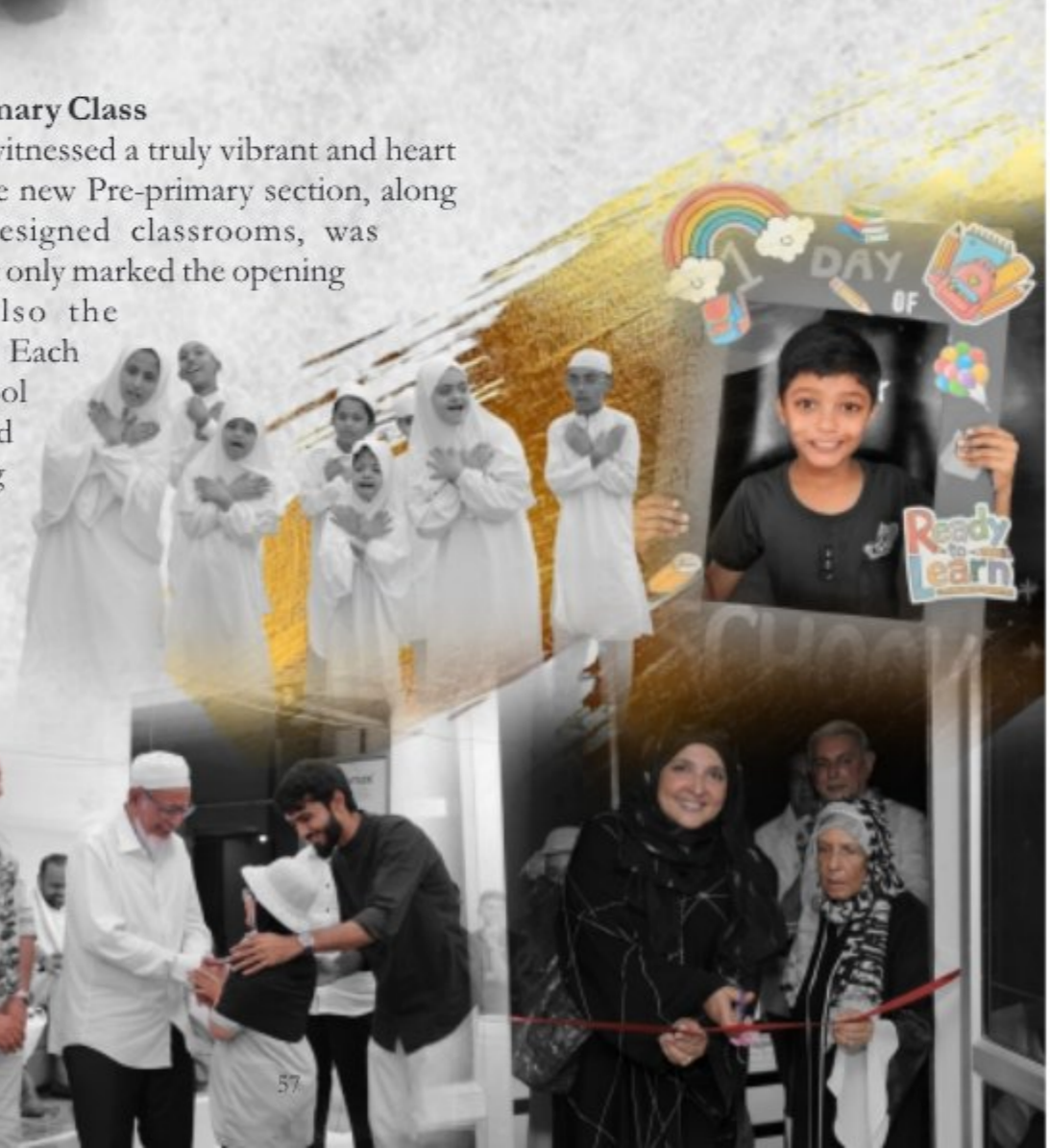

# Ahmed

## The Boy Who Found His Light

*“The real story of Mamta Rehab’s Ahmed”*

The year was 2013.

In the far end of Bharuch district, in a small house in Jambusar.

A home where about 11 people lived together laughing, talking, playing a true joint family.

In the evenings, conversations in the living room, rice cooking in the kitchen and amidst all of that, a tiny lamp of joy was born.

They named him Ahmed.

So beautiful that anyone who looked at him could not look away, and so innocent that the eyes never tired of him.

He was everyone’s beloved.

He would charm everyone young and old.

Whoever felt tired would smile instantly just by looking at Ahmed’s face.

As Ahmed grew, so did the family’s dreams

“Ahmed will become a doctor...”

“He will be the light of our future!”

The house may have been small,

but the palace of hopes they had built for Ahmed was tall - very tall.

But life! Life writes its own chapters.

Sometimes, life brings us to a turn where hope itself shatters under our feet.

One night, past midnight Ahmed suddenly developed a fever.

“Children get fever sometimes.”

Thinking so, his mother gave him medicine and put him to sleep. But the next day, instead of reducing, the fever kept rising.

He was taken to the village clinic. The doctor looked into his eyes and immediately said:

“Take this child to a big hospital right now”

Their legs trembled. Their hearts pounded.

Ahmed was admitted to a big hospital.

As the days passed, even the doctors began losing hope.

And one day!

the doctor told Ahmed’s parents:

“Pray... Everything now depends on the One above. We have done all we could,

but it doesn’t seem possible to do anything more...”

These were not words

they were like clouds breaking open and crashing down violently.

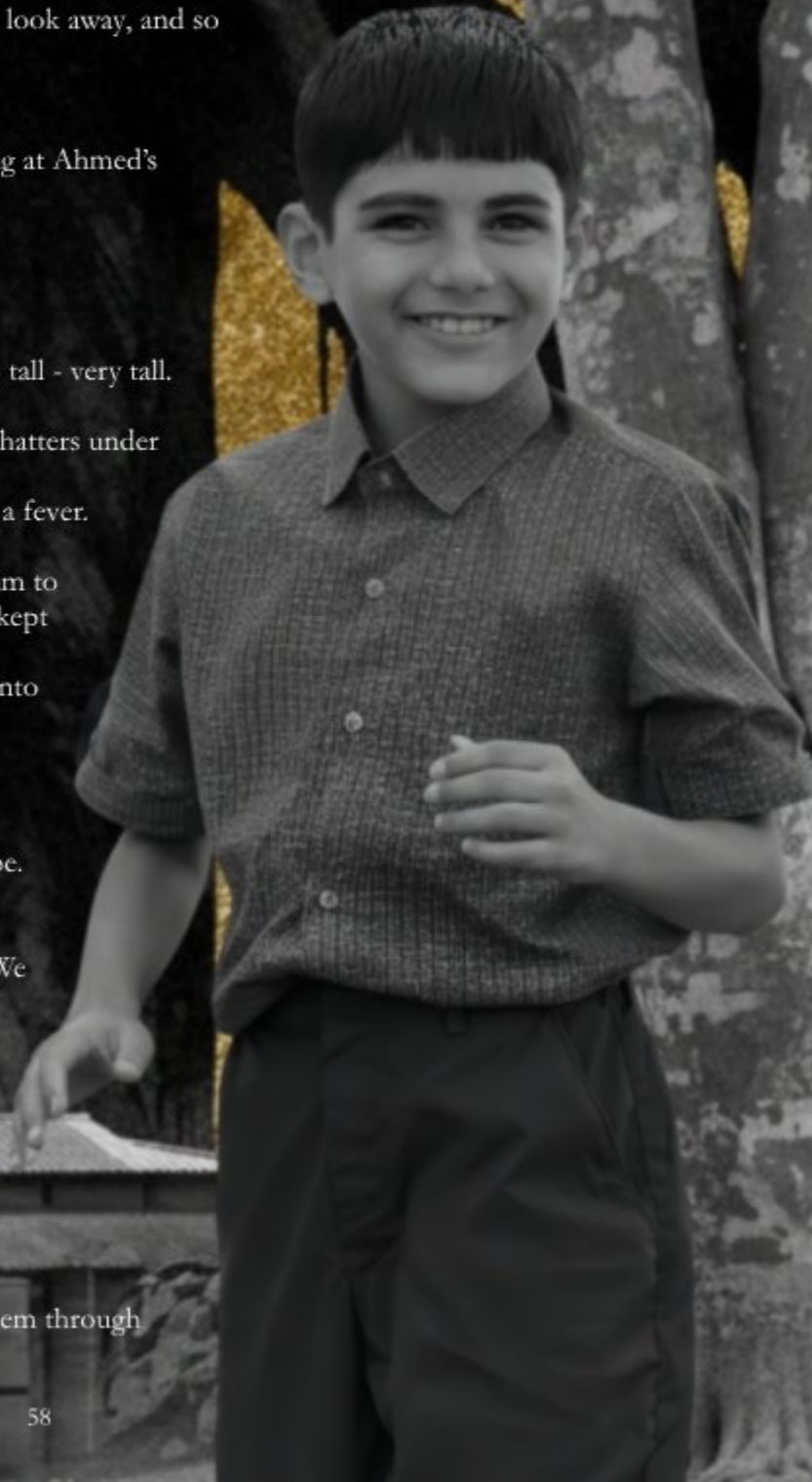
The mother’s eyes went blank the father’s heart collapsed within.

“No... no... my Ahmed will get better.

Please give him medicine, doctor.”

Tears, prayers, and a mother’s undying hope carried them through the days. And then a miracle.

Ahmed slowly started recovering from the fever.



The doctor said: “We did everything we could. But this survival, this is purely God’s mercy and your prayers.”

When he returned home, the courtyard filled with smiling faces welcomed him back.

His mother hugged him tightly, kissed his forehead with tearful eyes “My little lamp has come back...”

But...

something was missing.

Ahmed was no longer the same. He didn’t speak, didn’t understand, couldn’t walk properly. They consoled themselves: “He will slowly get better.”

“He was in the hospital for many days...”

This must be because of that.” But Ahmed’s behaviour grew worse. He would throw anything he got in his hands, would run and sit on any bike he saw,

He had no control over his body. He couldn’t do anything that children his age normally did.

They enrolled him in school, but even there, Ahmed wouldn’t understand, wouldn’t sit still. He cried moving from one class to another. If he saw anyone, he would run out of the school with them. He couldn’t speak like other children.

Finally, the school said: “This child is not typical.

We cannot keep him here.”

For the parents, this was a second heartbreak.

“Before our eyes, our child is drifting away from both worlds.” Now people slowly started distancing themselves from Ahmed.

The very eyes that once held dreams for him, now avoided meeting his. The father, with his small mobile repair shop, and a mind full of a thousand questions:

“Why is my Ahmed like this?

Is there any medicine? Where do we go?”

One day, a neighbour said: “Take this child to a brain specialist.” They hesitated “Why a brain doctor?

Not needed.”

But reality had to be faced. So early one morning, Ahmed’s parents took him to a big neuro hospital in Surat.

Tests were done, and the doctor said:

“Your child is mentally delayed.

He needs a therapy centre.”

The mother heard only two words “mentally delayed” and her heart silently broke.

The mother did not just hear the words “mentally delayed” she could not accept them not in her mind, not in her heart.

The sound of her hopes breaking from within. and yet, she began searching for a therapy centre.

But private therapy centres charged very high fees.

₹ 500 for just one hour! And no one could say when or whether he would improve.

Disheartened, they returned home that night.

But that very moment, that very night, Ahmed’s future changed.

Ahmed’s father met a coordinator (a social worker) from the WBVF (World Bharuchi Vahora Federation a community service organization). In conversation, Ahmed’s situation came up. So the father narrated everything. Without a second’s delay, the coordinator said: “Don’t worry at all.

WBVF’s ‘Mamta Rehab Center’ is made exactly for such children.”

The parents felt in their hearts:

“This answer is from God’s!” And then, 12 March, 2024

The scorching ground slowly cooling down into the soft evening light, with folded hands, empty eyes, and steps without understanding or direction 11-year-old Ahmed arrived at the doors of Mamta Rehab Center. All assessments were done.

After a brief discussion among the senior psychologists and doctors, one of the centre’s doctors took a deep breath and said calmly:

“You don’t need to worry anymore.

From here onwards, the responsibility is ours.”

These words, rebuilt the parents’ hopes and revived their courage.

And today, after just one year

Ahmed speaks, laughs from his heart, walks on his own, writes words, and now studies proudly in Mamta’s primary class. When someone asks where he goes,

Ahmed proudly says:

“At Mamta.”

The lamp that once had nearly extinguished today shines brightly again.

*Mamta did not change Ahmed.*

*Mamta understood him.*

Mamta firmly believes: Where there is understanding, only there does true education begin.

Ahmed says: “Mamta has taught me that even if the world passes any judgment on me, as long as I remain innocent in the courtroom of my conscience, I will live with courage.”

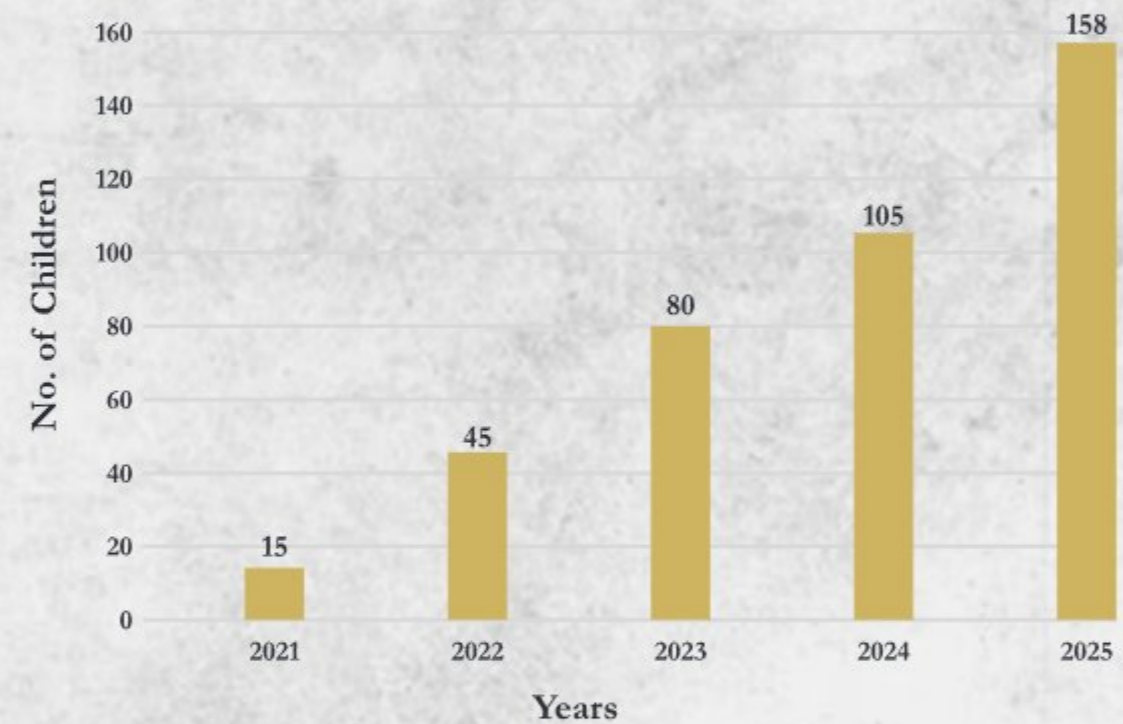

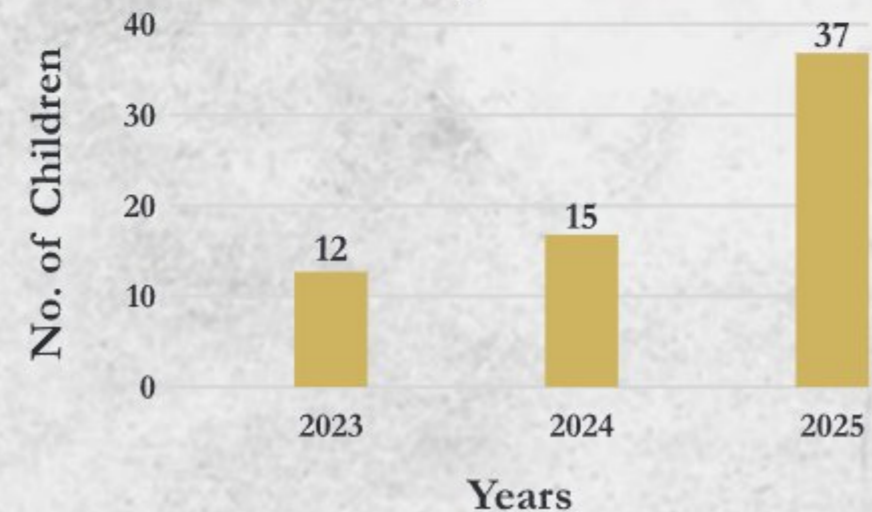

# An Inclusive Pathway to Livelihood Aleef Mart



*“Muflisi hiss-e-latafat ko mita deti hai.”*

*“When poverty grips a person, life turns into nothing more than a struggle for survival where beauty, gentleness, feeling, and the ability to savour life slowly begin to fade. Yet in every community; every human being has an unquestionable right to live with dignity and self-respect.”*

*“Jab insaan muflisi (gareebi) ka shikar hota hai, to uski zindagi sirf zinda rehne ki jang ban jaati hai, jismein khoobsurti, narimi, ehsaas aur lazzat mehsoos karne ki salahiyat kam hoti jaati hai, magar har ek kaum ko har ek insan ko izzat se jeene ka poora haq hai.”*

Aleef Mart is a community-driven commercial initiative operated through the WBVF Credit & Cooperative Society. The core objective of this initiative is to provide a dignified and sustainable market platform for economically weaker sections especially underprivileged families, widows, abandoned women, and other marginalised individuals. Many of these individuals possess skills and the ability to create small products from their homes, yet lack access to organised markets. Aleef Mart bridges this gap by promoting their products, connecting them to consumers, and supporting them in transforming everyday skills into stable livelihoods.

**Financial Support with Trust and Responsibility :** To ensure that lack of capital never becomes a barrier to self-reliance, WBVF Credit & Cooperative Society provides

financial assistance under an interest-free (Karj-E-hasna), community-based framework. This financial mechanism is not merely a loan system; it is a structured support model designed to strengthen confidence, continuity, and long-term economic stability.

**Empowering Youth through Practical Exposure :** Aleef Mart also serves as a valuable learning and growth platform for the youth of our community. Through direct involvement in retail and wholesale operations, young individuals gain exposure to bankable business concepts, market dynamics, and operational practices. This journey equips them with practical insights into entrepreneurship and prepares them for self-employment opportunities, creating a strong foundation for future enterprise development.

**Structured Operational Model :** Aleef Mart operates through two well-defined verticals: 1. Retail, 2. Wholesale

Both segments function in a systematic and organised manner, following standard operational procedures. Each vertical has shown consistent performance and contributes meaningfully to the overall sustainability of the initiative.

**Profit Distribution :** The profits generated through Aleef Mart are managed transparently by the Aleef Mart Committee in alignment with cooperative principles. The surplus is utilised as follows:

- A portion is distributed among registered community members (Sabhasad) of the Cooperative Society.
- A portion is reserved for future planning, expansion, and long-term sustainability initiatives.

This ensures that the benefits of growth return to the community and support continuous development.

**A Unified Platform for Livelihood Creation :** Aleef Mart brings together individuals from diverse economic backgrounds onto a single, united platform. From small home-based producers to aspiring entrepreneurs, it offers equal opportunities to participate,

contribute, and grow. This collective approach creates employment opportunities at multiple levels and strengthens economic collaboration within the community.

**Looking Ahead, Sakhi Mandal Livelihood Models :** In the near future, WBVF Credit & Cooperative Society plans to establish multiple Sakhi mandal (model) under the Aleef Mart framework. These models will primarily focus on empowering women by offering them structured, home-linked employment opportunities. This initiative aims to enhance economic independence, self-confidence, and social dignity for women across many families within the community.

*Aleef Mart stands as a meaningful extension of WBVF’s cooperative economic vision. Rooted in ethical practices and collective responsibility, this initiative reflects a commitment to sustainable livelihoods, inclusive development, and long-term community empowerment. # Common Service Center



In an era where digital access defines opportunity, many individuals still struggle with complex online procedures and documentation. The Common Service Centre (CSC) bridges this gap, bringing essential government and educational services within everyone's reach.

With trained staff, the CSC simplifies every step of the process, from form filling to submission and follow-ups, ensuring that no eligible person is left behind due to technical barriers or lack of awareness.

## Bharuch Block

Government and Scholarship Assistance: Facilitated essential services such as Namo Lakshmi Scholarship applications, college admission forms, Aadhaar updates, and Ration Card E-KYCs, ensuring smooth and efficient processing for community members.

To further extend these benefits to the community, all services are also provided at the WBVF Block Offices in Jambusar and Vadodara, making assistance easily accessible to a larger number of beneficiaries across the region.

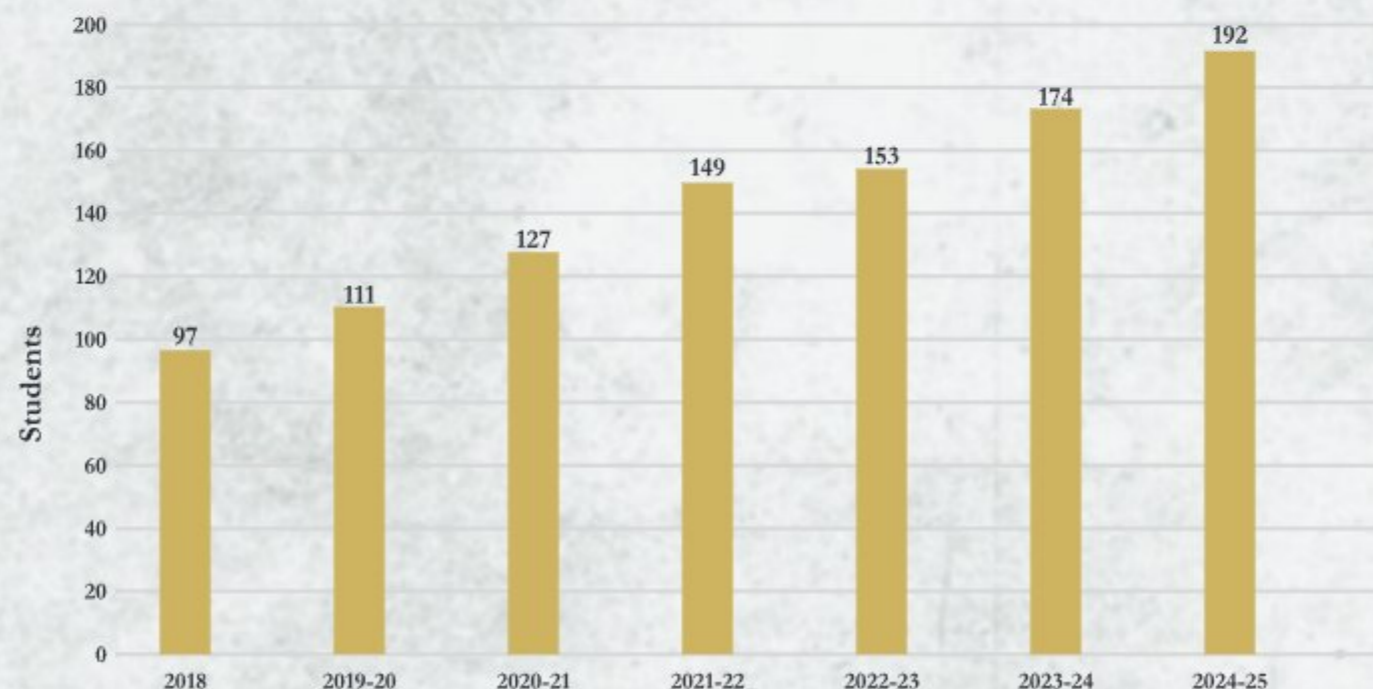

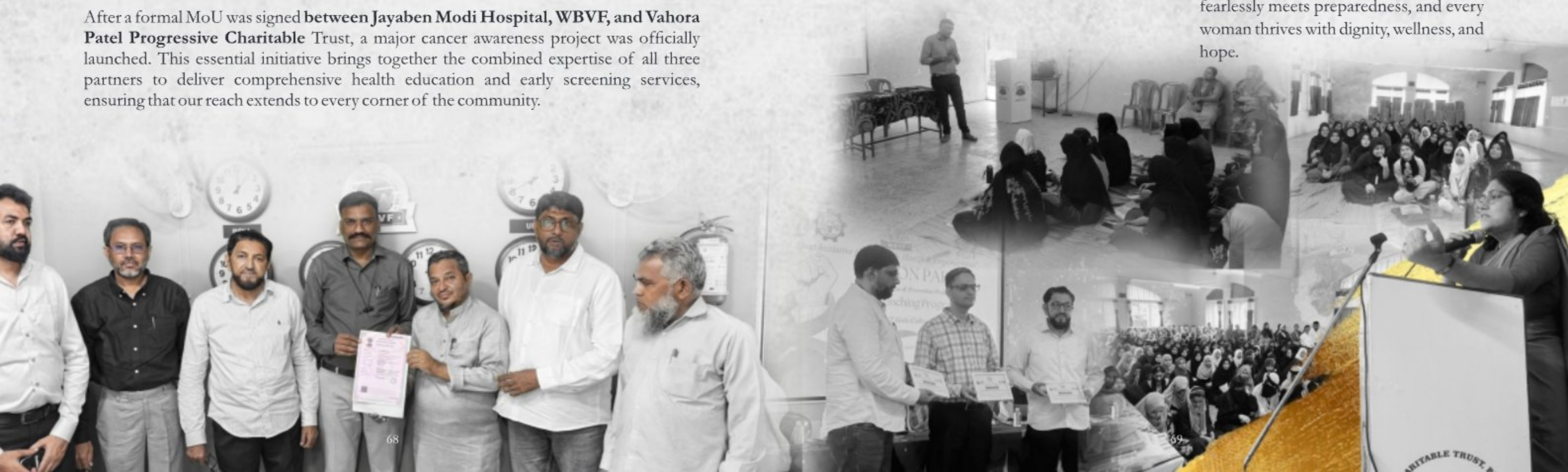
- **Health and Awareness:** Breast cancer awareness campaigns were organized with gynecologists and psychologists to educate women about health and lifestyle.

Here, every child is made to feel that they belong as a part of a family that listens to them, understands them, and stands beside them like a caring parent. It is a shelter of hope wrapped in empathy. Behind every smile of these children lies a quiet story of struggle. Growing up without a father's presence means facing emotional emptiness and daily hardships that no child should ever encounter.

Mission Kafalat was born from this very reality, to fill those empty spaces with hope, to rebuild their courage, and to stand as their unwavering support. Through financial assistance, emotional guidance, identity, and continuous mentoring, WBVF ensures these children rise with dignity, confidence, and direction.

## Key Activities

On 3rd & 4th May 2025, at the MMMCT Campus, Bharuch, a special gathering was organized for 370 children and their mothers.

This meet-up was arranged batch-wise:

- **Age 12–18:** 3rd May
- **Age 0–12 & 18–25:** 4th May

The purpose of this gathering was deeply meaningful. WBVF has always supported special-category students through scholarships, but this time, we wanted to go a step further. A dedicated counselling sessions was arranged so that these children and their mothers could share their real challenges, and openly express

the struggles they quietly carry every day. What touched us most was that families opened up in the very first session, something we never expected. Many mothers expressed that they do not seek only financial support, they want to become self-independent, and several showed interest in learning new skills as well so they could contribute to their family's well-being with dignity and confidence. This honesty, openness, and willingness to grow reflects the deep trust families have in WBVF, and it became one of the most meaningful outcomes of this initiative. Educational kits distributed to 74 families at MMMCT Campus.

## One-to-One Psychological Counselling

A total of 74 families were scheduled for individual psychological counselling, including comprehensive assessments and documentation.

The focus remains on providing educational support, emotional care, and building a safe and encouraging environment for these children.

Upcoming plan- As the Scholarship Program unfolds, the 74 families under Mission Kafalat will be approached separately. It has been decided that these families will receive personal guidance and support, ensuring trust, comfort, and emotional connection, exactly as envisioned by the true spirit of Mission Kafalat.

To uphold complete transparency and ensure the privacy and dignity of every family, we consciously chose not to take any photographs of this project.

## Behind every child

is a story we may never fully see, but through Mission Kafalat, we were blessed with the opportunity to **listen closely, understand deeply**, and stand beside families who continue to rise despite unimaginable hardships. This year, during our One-to-One Counselling sessions, we entered homes where silence itself spoke. Some mothers carried worries they had never shared aloud. Some children held dreams far bigger than the world they are growing up in. And in every family, we found a quiet strength, sometimes fragile, sometimes fierce, but always present. From these interactions, one truth became clear: These families reminded us that strength is not always loud it appears in the

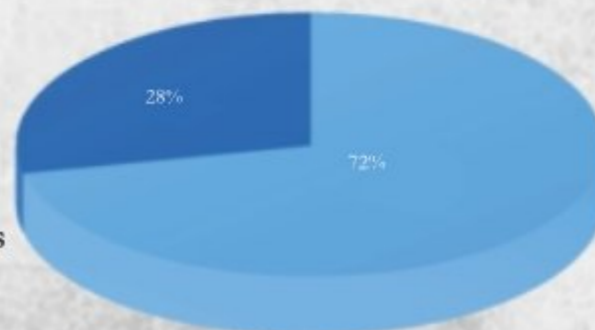
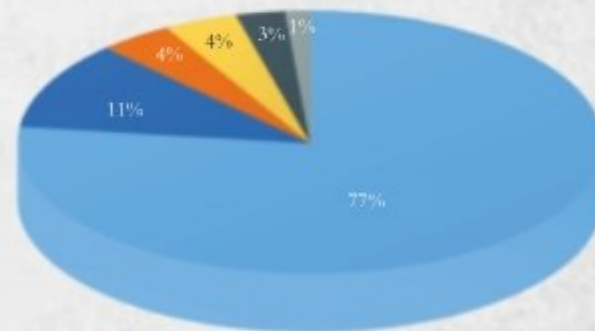

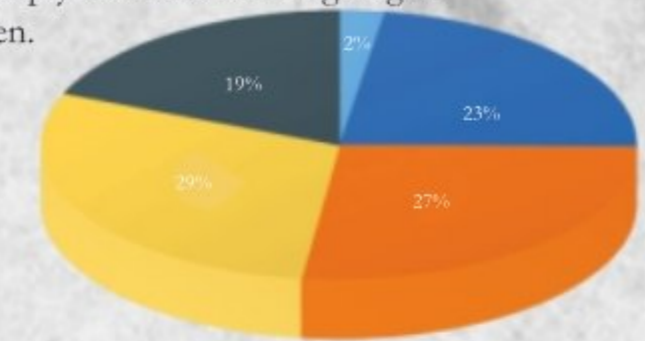
quiet efforts every single day. Sometimes, it is a family surviving with patience, faith, and whatever they have. Mission Kafalat continues to walk with them, step by step. Because every child deserves dignity, every mother deserves support, and every family deserves a chance to rebuild their life with stability, opportunity, and emotional strength. Each chart that follows represents more than data. It represents a struggle someone is living through, a responsibility someone is carrying, and a future someone is still holding on to. These visuals help us understand the journey of our families **where support is needed the most, where resilience shines the brightest, and where Mission Kafalat continues to make a meaningful difference.**



### 3. Education

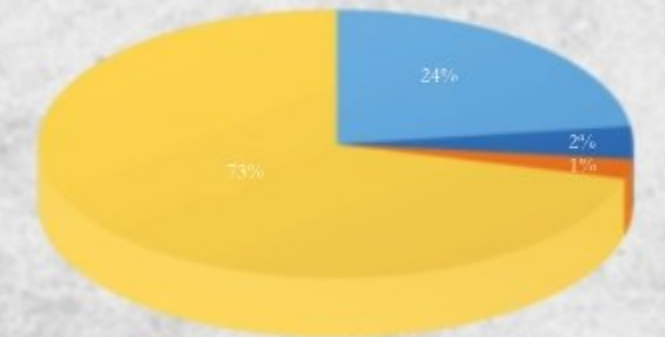
Every child we met carries a dream some want to become teachers, some want to serve their community, and others simply want to continue going to school without fear of fees or financial burden. Our assessment showed:

- Nursery / LKG / UKG: 3 students
- Primary (1<sup>st</sup> - 5<sup>th</sup> Standard): 28
- Middle School (6<sup>th</sup> - 8<sup>th</sup> Standard): 33
- Secondary (9<sup>th</sup> - 10<sup>th</sup> Standard): 36
- Higher Secondary (11<sup>th</sup> - 12<sup>th</sup> Std): 23



### 4. Education Support

- School fees pending: 29
- Tuition fees pending: 3
- School & Tuition fees pending: 1
- No support needed: 90



Along with these main areas, a few other observations came up during the assessment, giving us a real sense of both struggle and strength in these families. Across homes, mothers quietly take on so many responsibilities. They work from home- tailoring, cooking, embroidery, running small shops, or teaching, always trying to make sure their families have enough, even when support is little or uncertain. Sometimes relatives help in ways that go unnoticed, and sometimes they don't, yet these women keep going with quiet determination.

Beyond money and resources, what stands out is the spirit and hope these families carry. Some children have special talents, a young footballer dreaming big despite financial limits. Some mothers face the challenges of remarriage, absent fathers, or distant family, yet they still try to give their children love, stability, and care.

These stories show a delicate mix of struggle and courage. Every family carries silent strength, hope, and a love that never gives up. Behind every challenge is a story of unwavering care, dreams that matter, and hearts that keep believing.

**Across all 74 families, one message was clear:**

**They are not just asking for financial support, but more than that, dignity, encouragement, and the chance to give their children a better tomorrow.**

“Even a small act, your time, your empathy, or dua can become a child's strength for life. To bring a smile to the face of an orphan (yateem) is not just kindness, It's an act, beloved to Allah<sup>ﷻ</sup>, and the most beautiful forms of reward (sawab).”

This is not the end, it's only the beginning..... as we move ahead, the journey continues with consistent care.
